The 2017 Rosé is dry Grenache that comes in at 11.8% alcohol. This, the winery says, is harvested a bit early to keep acidity. This was seen a few months ago, but it seemed impressive. It is worth checking back to see how it settled in. It is good that they picked early, because this has lots of depth and richness for a pink. The Grenache is big and seems ripe even with that 11.8% alcohol. It is basically a lighter styled red, meaty, a little gamey, concentrated and serious—it really needs that acidity. Overall, this is well done, solid and delicious.
